



St. David's Summer Lunch Program

Meals served from June 5- July 14

What is this program? This is an authorized summer lunch program sponsored by Topeka USD 501 and the Kansas Department of Education. Menus and food will be prepared by the food service staff of Topeka 501 and delivered Monday-Friday to the site. Volunteers from St. David's will serve the meals.

When is this program? Food service begins on June 5 and will run until July 14. Hot meals will be served from 11-12 Monday through Friday. Kids will also have 30 minutes to read, work on an art project or play a game.

Who is eligible to eat? Any child age 1-18 will be eligible to have a free meal which includes any of our children (or grandchildren) at St. David's. **No identification, income requirements or registration is required.** Just show up to eat and enjoy an hour out.

How are the kid's meals paid for? This program is federally funded through the USDA and the Kansas State Department of Education and administered by Topeka 501 as part of their summer school lunch program.

What about adults? Can they eat too? Yes, any adult may eat at a cost of \$4. In addition, our congregation has identified financial resources that will allow us to also offer a complimentary meal to adult caregivers who accompany children to the site. We will have a limited amount of complimentary meals available so we will offer these on a first come basis each week.

Where is St. David's? It is on the northwest corner of 17th and Gage (3916 SW. 17th St.) There is parking off of 17th on the west side of the building. St. David's is also on the Topeka Metro bus line with bus stops at 17th and Gage. We will have signs directing you and your children to the food site entrance. Meals will be served in our parish hall.

St. David's Members Volunteer Information:

How much time will we be needed each day? Volunteers will be needed each day to set-up, serve, help with activities and clean-up. We expect that you will be here under 2 hours.

What would I be doing? We will need greeters, servers, and activity workers. There will be standing required for most jobs. Activity workers should expect to work directly with the kids to help with reading and artwork. There may be some physical activities on certain days.

I've volunteered to serve food. What do I need to do? We need a core of our volunteers who are willing to learn the food safety and handling rules. If you can attend a training on May 26 from 9-11 hosted by Topeka 501, please let Mary Becker know. If you can't attend that training, that is fine. You will be given further instructions when you show up to work.
