Doorstep, Fellowship & Faith Ministries, I-Care, Let's Help, Rescue Mission, Salvation Army, Topeka North Outreach

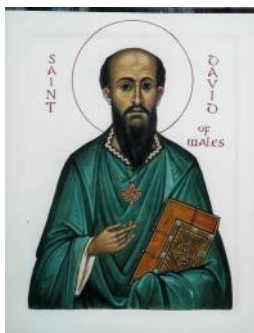
