**Advise for church participation during the corona virus concerns:** please exchange the peace by placing your hand on your heart and wishing each other peace (no touching please). For receiving communion, receiving only the bread is full communion. If you wish to receive the wine as well, please either dip your bread into the chalice of wine, no fingers in the wine please, or drink from the cup as usual. We are using the silver vessels throughout Lent because they are safer than the pottery. Also all servers will clean their hands before distributing communion and we will wipe and turn the chalice after each person. Your chances of becoming ill from receiving communion are very slim but please do what you are comfortable with.
