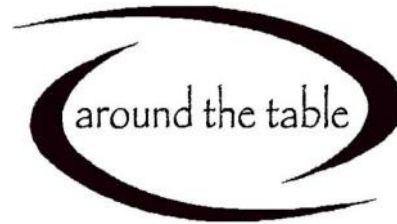

REGISTER FOR SHAREFEST
 Volunteers are needed for Sharefest. Outreach Ministry has again decided to participate in Topeka Sharefest to be held on Saturday, April 27 from 8am to noon. This is the seventh year for St. David's to participate in this event. Sharefest is a network of Topeka churches

and organizations working together to serve others and to demonstrate the love of Christ in the community by serving USD 501 and other non-profit organizations that are impacting children and families in the Topeka area. Participation requires only four hours of your time on the morning of April 27. A sign-up table will be set up in the narthex for two weeks starting the weekend of March 30 and 31 and continuing through April 7. Registrations can be completed at the sign-up table or you may register online at sharefesttopeka.com. Dennis Hodgins is again serving as our coordinator.
