## Youth News

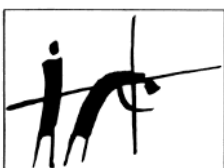

### REGISTER FOR SHAREFEST



Volunteers are still needed for Sharefest to be held on Saturday, April 27 from 8am to noon. This is the seventh year for St. David's to participate in this event. Sharefest is a network of Topeka churches and organizations working together to serve

others and to demonstrate the love of Christ in the community by serving USD 501 and other non-profit organizations that are impacting children and families in the Topeka area. Participation requires only four hours of your time on the morning of April 27. We have learned there are already adequate workers at Randolph Elementary. In order that all St. Davidians will be assigned to the same site, it has been arranged for us all to work together at Lowman Hill Elementary, 1101 SW Garfield. We will be doing both painting and landscape work so wear your work clothes.
