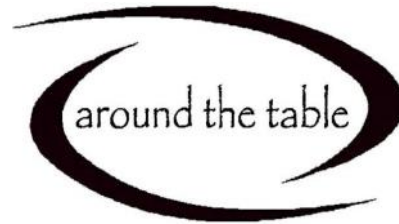

Grace Cathedral, Topeka

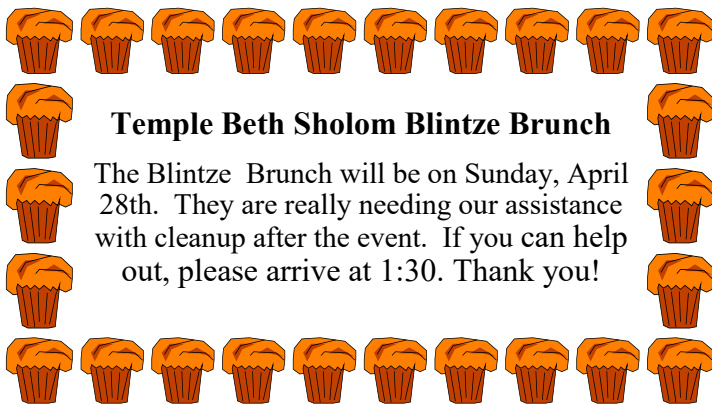
