Every child that attends gets to dig for one item each day and get a huge kick out of it, so, our supplies are constantly running low.

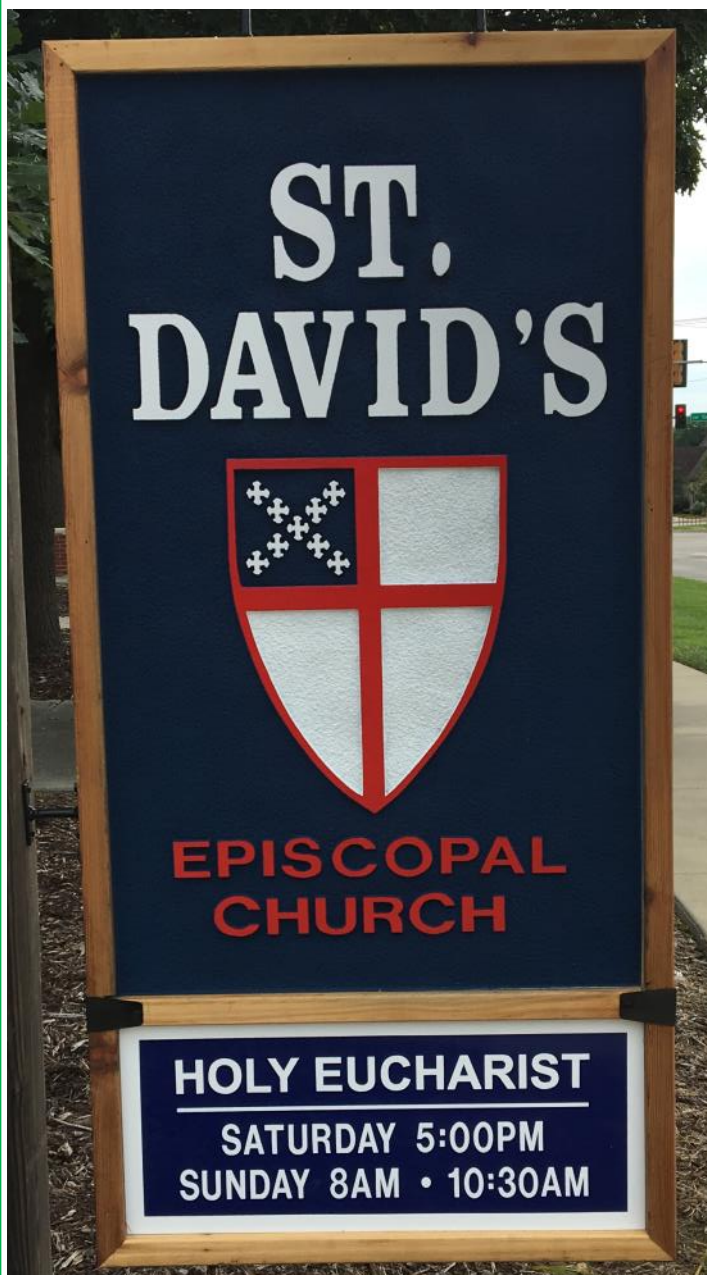

## St David's New Signs

The sign pictured replaces our sign on 17th St that fell and broke over the winter. This sign is be made of a strong, weather resistant foam, making it much lighter and longer lasting.

The other sign is the electronic sign on the corner of 17th and Gage- the one we've been talking about for a long time. The funding for this sign comes from unused 2017 endowment funds, 2018 endowment funds, a \$5000 anonymous donation and up to \$5000 from the Parish Life Committee (who've been raising funds for this sign for several years.) Scott Davis is donating the brickwork and we are getting bids for the electrical work.

Work on the sign should begin in June, with final installation in 10-12 weeks. We are excited about these new opportunities to increase our visibility in the community.
