## FACILITY MANAGEMENT

### A note from your building manager

One of the largest monthly bills we have to deal with is utility cost, namely our gas and electric bills. As summer temps have come upon us, I wanted to address ways that we can help mitigate that cost!

With the exception of the center part of the building (mainly the office spaces), our building thermostats operate in zones and are controlled by smart thermostats. I program them weekly based on what is going on in our building. When the areas are not in use, they sit at 80 degrees during the summer. For the zones to work properly we need to shut doors! Frequently I come in after hours to find the kitchen and/or Parish Hall doors wide open. The hallway to the west of those doors operates on another zone, meaning it is pumping that cooled air into a space that is sitting at 80 degrees. This drives up cost. **Please, shut doors if you are the last person leaving a room!**

This also applies to the lights! Many times I'll drive by the building (especially at night) and see lights on in an empty building. **If you are the last ones to leave a room, please take a second and make sure the lights are off.**

Please help us try to bring our heating and cooling bills in check!
