Out of our call to love, considering the current spike in COVID-19 cases across Kansas, and after consultation with medical advisers, the Executive Committee of the Council of Trustees, and the Council of Deans, Bishop Cathleen Bascom is requiring that all people over two years of age – vaccinated and unvaccinated alike – wear masks for all indoor worship and gatherings in Episcopal churches in the Diocese of Kansas. This will continue through October 1, 2021. At that time the mask policy will be reviewed, in consideration of COVID-19 cases and vaccination rates. She further stated that new recommendations regarding communion and safe approaches to fellowship and food will be forthcoming.

Canon Patrick Funston will be our celebrant and preacher for this Saturday and Sunday services, August 14 & 15.

Bishop Cathleen will be making a visitation to St David's on **Sunday, September 26**.
