COVID CHANGES:

Due to the increased numbers of Covid cases in Shawnee County, and on the advice of experts, St David's is making the following changes to our procedures:

- 1) Sunday School will not begin until at least **Oct. 1**.
- 2) We hope to have choir in place for Advent 1.
- 3) Because we are limiting movement in the Nave, we will not be having processions, which means we will not be using acolytes, Eucharistic ministers or vergers for the foreseeable future. We will also continue with communion in one kind only.

Please remember that masks are required for all services and meetings, regardless of vaccination status.

This is incredibly frustrating for all of us, but we have to err on the side of caution in the face of this pandemic.
