

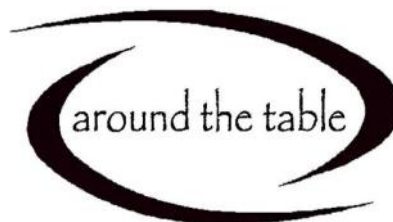

Until further notice, there is no congregational singing allowed per diocesan requirements.

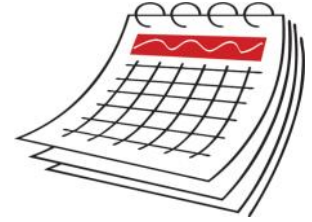
