

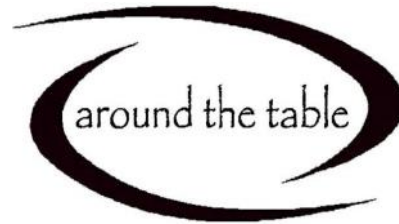

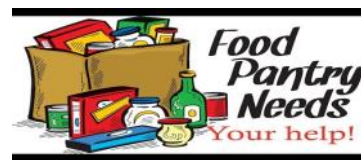
We need those delicious brownies to the church by 10:00 am, the 25th, when they will be picked up. This is a favorite treat which is very appreciated!
