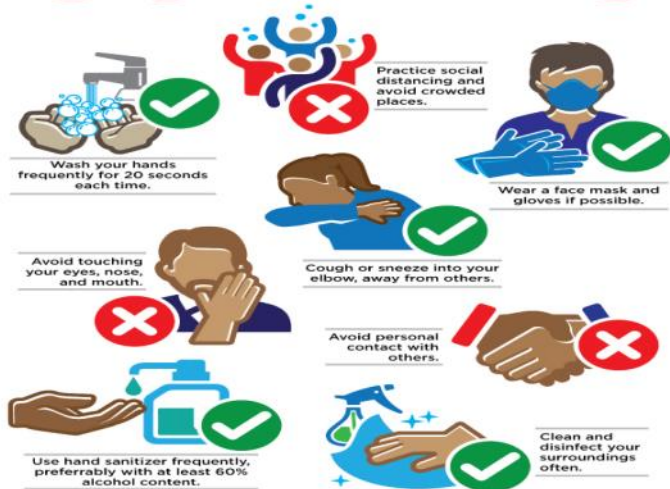
Rector's Pantry

The Rector's Pantry is running low on vegetables, (with the exception of green beans), canned fruit, canned meats, hand soap and toothpaste.

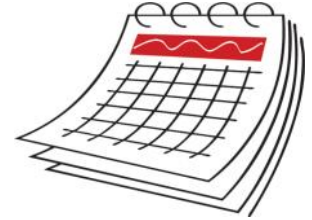
