



Fall is Here... it's the beginning of the holiday season!

Doorstep's basement was flooded on August 30 by a
city sewer back-up. This was blamed on the heavy
rainfall that morning. Insurance did not cover the ex-
pense of the clean-up and repair (roughly \$18,000),
and the loss of at least one-third of our Christmas
Store donations we had collected. We know we lost a
lot of blankets, backpacks, school supplies and toys.
All school aged children receive new school supplies
at the Christmas Store. We always need toys for all
ages. If you can help out we would appreciate it!
