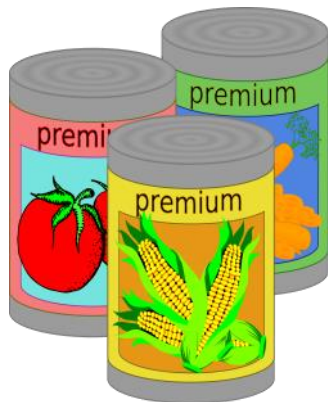

We are fortunate to receive several grants which make providing these funds possible. Particularly, United Way of Greater Topeka Basic Needs, City of Topeka and Shawnee County Social Services. Our small staff and mighty group of dedicated volunteers have been doing all we can for our neighbors in need!

We are working hard on our Inaugural Neighbor Helping Neighbor Walk/5K Run set for Saturday, October 6th at Lake Shawnee. We plan for this to become our second signature fundraiser each year in the Fall. We finally found an event that does not focus on food!
